

## Gospel Terminology

Justification - an instantaneous act by God, who legally declares a person's righteous (just) standing before Him based on the Work of Christ.	Romans 4:24-5:1, Gal. 2:16, Rom. 3:26-38, Rom. 8:33-34
Propitiation - the exhausting of God's holy wrath by the worthy sacrifice of Jesus changing God's attitude toward us.	Hebrews 2:17, I John 2:2, 4:10, Rom. 3:25
Atonement - The Work that Christ did in His life and Death to earn our pardon and salvation	Heb. 9:23-26, Luke 24:25-27, Phil. 3:9
Penal Substitution - In our place Christ bore the just punishment that was due us because of our sins	Rom. 5:6-8, John 19:30
Redemption - Christ paying the price for our freedom from bondage to sin, death, and Satan (the purchasing of a slave)	I Peter 1:18-19, Mark 10:45 (Ransom)
Adoption - the transaction whereby we receive all the rights and privileges of being God's children, placed into His family.	John 1:12, Eph. 1:5, Rom. 8:14-17, Gal. 3:23-26, I John 3:1-2
Imputation - the giving/placing of righteousness on my account from Christ's account	Rom. 3:4-6, Rom. 5:17, Phil. 3:9, I Cor. 1:30
Regeneration - The miraculous act of God where new life is placed in the believer - called "being born again."	James 1:18, I Pet. 1:3, John 3:3-8, Ez. 36:26-27
Reconciliation - The process where man and God are brought back into a relationship (ultimately it's the reconciliation of God's love and His anger)	II Cor. 5:18-19, Rom. 5:9-11
Sanctification - the synergistic and progressive process of one becoming more like Jesus in their lives	I Cor. 6:11, Rom. 6:11-18, Col. 3:1-3, Eph. 4, I Pet. 1:15, Phil. 2:12-13
Glorification - the instantaneous transformation of ones mortal and physical fallen being into an immortal un-fallen being	Rom. 8:17, 30, I Cor. 15:51-52, Rom. 8:11, Heb. 11:10-16
Indwelling Spirit - The very Spirit of God living within the believer/ residing/ abiding with his spirit	Rom. 5:5, Rom 8, Gal. 5
Indwelling Sin - The reality of a believers state as thoroughly sinful with the remaining flesh that cannot serve God	Rom. 5:12-21, Rom. 8:7, Rom. 7:14-25
